

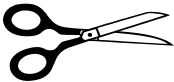
11th Celebrating Agriculture

2. If you will have **food, samples or sales**, you will need to bring a **Certificate of Insurance** with the Woodstock Agricultural Society & Celebrating Agriculture, as additional insured for the day. **Animals must have appropriate health forms.**
3. You may only sell your Ag products with an exhibit or agriculture related educational message in your sales display. You must conform to the Connecticut Health Code and meet Northeast Department of Health requirements for food items.
